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
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



Shikshapatri

The Epistle of Precepts
(based on Shatanand's Shikshapatri
Arthadipika)
By Pravin S. Varsani

Text 50

Thereafter, sitting in one place, they shall brush their teeth, bathe with clean water and then wear one washed cloth around the waist and one around the upper part of the body.

One must perform Datana (brushing their teeth) sitting in one place. Smruti strictly forbids any other way of brushing: Na Tishtam Brajan Kuryan Na Svapan Dantdhavan- 'one should never brush their teeth while standing, walking or lying down.' One must also perform Datana whilst observing 'Moun Vrata' - vow of silence. Datana should be performed using water and the famed sticks of wood. Vishnu explains such famed piece of wood: 'A stick of wood which has thaws and milk-like juice should be used. It should be twelve finger in length and one finger in width. One end should be made into free bristles at a depth of half a finger.'

Skanda Purana explains, 'According to their caste, all should perform *Datana* with a stick of wood which is shorter by one finger length.' Thus *Shudras* should use a twelve finger-width length *Datana*, *Vaishyas* an eleven length *Datana* etc. *Vashishta* writes, 'One should not perform *Datana* on days of *Upavaas* (fasting) and *Shraadh* (ancestral offering).' This is forbidden due to the use of wood. *Vyaas* explains, 'On days of *Upavaas* or days on which *Datana* cannot be found, one should wash their mouth with water twelve times.; *Krutyachinamani* explains, 'Samavedis

(Brahmins) should use *Datana* of eight finger-widths.'

After Datana one should bath using pure water. Padma Purana explains what 'pure' water means: 'Bathing daily in the cold water of a sea, river, stream or a well is considered the best.' Bathing in cold water is considered to be better but obviously those who cannot through old age or illness may bathe using warm water. Manu strictly forbid the use of hot water for bathing in many instance: 'One should not bathe using hot water when there is a death in a family, a birth, period of astrological transition (Sankranti), during Shraadh- the time of ancestral offerings, one's own birthday and after an eclipse of the sun or moon.'

Katyayan informs us of the way in which bathing is to be performed: Praataha Shankshepataha Snaanam Madhyena Tu Savistaram- 'One should bathe in short (Shankshepa) at daybreak (Praatahakala) and then in full (extensively) at noon. Those who do not act in this way never receive the intended fruits of acts of sacrifices (Yagnas) etc.'

In Mitakshara, Shatatap Muni explains the consequences of not bathing at daybreak: *Praataha Snaanam Vini Nityan Dwijo Bhavati Sutaki*- they are forever *Stuaki*- an untouchable and impure. **Skanda Purana** explains the merits of bathing at daybreak: 'Those who bathe at daybreak satiate their ancestors and the Gods. Their actions become pure and worthwhile.' Therefore it is important that '*Snaan Vidhi*' is carried out properly and a level o cleanliness is maintained which is acceptable.

After bathing, one should wear a piece of cloth around the waist (usually a Dhoti for men) and one around the upper body (Sala). These articles of clothing should be washed and clean. **Dharma Pradeep** explains that such articles of clothing are not considered to be pure and clean if

washed by a woman, hence such clothings for this purpose must be washed by the individuals themselves. **Smruti Sangraha** explains the deeper meaning of 'pure' clothes and hence, that which is considered as unclean, 'A cotton garment worn around the waist, a silk cloth worn whilst eating and any dirty garments are already to be washed.'

The specifications regarding size etc. of the garment to be worn are now given: the cloth for the lower part of the body should be seven or eight arm lengths long and a quarter of that wide. The garment should be relatively new made from white linen. The upper body cloth should be half that of the lower in length.

In this way two garments should be used: *Vasasi Pridhaniyamutriyam Cheti Dve Vastre Paridharye* — one which is worn and one which is used to cover says Hari Harkarimama. To use only one cloth is unacceptable as such use is considered to be comparable to being naked. In addition *Brahmcharis*, *Brahmins* etc. should wear a loincloth and *Janoi* (sacred thread).

In Krutyachintamani, Jatukarnya Muni explains, 'Those who were dirty clothes, a loin cloth on its own, does not wear a loin cloth, does not wear an upper cloth, who wears the red Bhagwa clothing, a wet garment, sticky clothing and sewn garment, are considered as naked.'

Jatukarnya Muni forbids eating with only one clothing worn. Similarly acts such as Japan Daan and Yagnas do not provide the fruits which one expects if only one garment is worn.

These *Shlokas* are for the good of man. The *Nitya Karmas* are there for personal purification and so it is important that form the time we make up in the morning, we keep our mind focussed for the act of purification. It should be concentrated upon god. Many have a habit of waking up first thing in the morning and

watching television. He then casually goes into the bathroom whenever he feels up to

We must realise that the morning is to be dedicated to God and these other things should be far from one's mind. When walking, we should meditate upon God for few minutes and the go the bathroom to see to morning duties. Whilst bathing, we should sing the Lord's name, chant his glorious name or sing *Kirtans* and remember and chant the great rivers of India. Surely these acts will be more beneficial than singing other sons.

If you need to listen to something in the morning then listen to *Katha* of God or *Bhajans* and not Hindi film songs. It is important that the morning ritual, involving remembrance of the Lord is taught to the young sot that they can practice it from an early age. Those children who follow such an ethical code become virtuous and respected throughout their lives. Only those who remember God daily in this way are themselves remembered by God and ultimately hi choicest blessings are showered upon such pure devotees of God. Lord Swaminarayan now explains the *Pooja Vidhi*.

Aasana

- Sadhu Purushottamprakashdas (Jetalpurdham)

In our *Vedic* and *Pauranik Poojan Vidhi* various types of *Aasanas* and their benefits are prescribed for performing *Japa, Tapa, yagna, Dhyan, Mantra*. Role of Asanas is very important in *Karya Siddhi*.

According to Science, magnetic pressure of the Northern Pole pervades on all objects lying on the earth towards the North. Our human body is consisted of five elements and therefore this magnetic pressure also has its effect on our body. Therefore, while performing Japa, Tapa, Daan, yagna and Hom Pooja, divine spiritual energy is created in our body and if at that time our body is connected with the earth then such a divine energy passes through the earth and it clashes with the internal energy of the earth which creates quarrel and diseases in our body and our house. Therefore, our great Rishis have framed rules of covering our body with special kind of cloth and our head with cap or hat or any other type of covering. These are basic rules for performing any Japa, Tapa, Dhyan and Pooja and they must be followed scrupulously.

In Shloka-51 of 'Shiksha Patri' Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan has stated:

''उपविश्य ततः शुध्धः आसने शुचि भूतले असडफीर्ण उपस्पृश्यं''

"Then they shall sit in a clean place, on a clean and suitable cloth, untouched by others and facing north or east shall perform Achaman."

There are detailed descriptions about the best type of *Asana* to be used while performing *Japa, Tapa* or *Dhyan.* The wooden seat should be admeasuring 24* 16 finger and with the height of 04 fingers.

The cloth seat should be admeasuring 2 * ½ so that one can sit comfortably. *Asana* which does not touch the land is considered to be the best *Asana*.

There are certain standard Asanas made of Darbha, woollen shawl or blanket, *Mrig-Charm, Vyaghra-Charm*, silver cloth, cotton cloth etc. among Asanas made of wood it can be made from *Shami, Kadamb, Varun, Kher, Shon* etc. types of wood. Grihasthi devotees should not use Asana made of *Vyaghra-Charma*.

In Yog Sutra, Bhagwan Vyasji writes that if one sits on earth without any Asana, he suffers from a number of diseases. Asanas made of the minerals, plastic material such as carpet should not be used as they are harmful to our body and life in a number of ways.

This earth is home for all the human being as well as all other living organisms. This earth is the wife of the Lord Shree Vishnu and as we are the children of the Almighty Lord, this earth is our mother. Therefore, all our actions should begin only after we perform *Pranam* to this motherland.

After performing *pooja-Karma*, one should three *Achaman* water to the land under the *Aasan* and should touch the water on forehead. This will transmit the energy of the earth into our body.

Now there is one warning. If one is required to stand up while *Pooja-Yagna-Karma* etc. are going on or during the recess time, then he should stand up only after folding his *Asanas*. Because, the deities like Indra, though they have no right of *Karma* on *Prithvi Lok*, they may take seat of *Sadhak*, if Asana is not folded and may take away the fruits of *Pooja* performed so far.

Janmangal Abhiyan

- Sadguru Shastri Swami Chaitanyaswaroopdasji (Koteshwar)

With the directions and blessings of H.H. Shri Acharya 1008 Shri Koshalendraprasadji Maharaj, 'Janmangal Kanthasth Abhiyan' is being organized by Shree Narnarayandev Yuvak Mandal, Ahmedabad on the occasion of Rajat Jayanti Mahamahotsav 2013 of Shree Narnarayandev Yuvak Mandal, Ahmedabad. This is an opportunity to understand in detail each name of Almighty Lord as contained in Janmangal Namavali created by Sadguru Shatanand Swami. Nothing more can be said about Janmangal Namavali- in fact it is an essence of all the scriptures.

It is benevolent and Janmangalkari for all the human beings. A person who performs *Path* of this *Janmangal Namavali*, gets the fruits of performing *Path* of *Satsangijivan*.

Once Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan directed Sadguru Shatanand Swami to create such a scripture which may contain all Leela-Charitra of Almighty Lord and at the same time it may be nice and wonderful combination of all Niyam, Nischay and Paksha. Accordingly, Sadguru Shatanand Swami created the wonderful scripture, which contains 05 Chapters, 360 Adhyay and more than 17,000 Shlokas. And it is wonderful 'Satsangijivan Shastra'. A person who performs Path of this scripture 'Satsangijivan Shastra' everyday, he never becomes unhappy in his life. But this scripture is so lengthy that it is not possible to perform complete Path of this Scripture on everyday; and therefore, Sadguru Shatanand Swami created a smaller scripture called 'Sarvamangal Namavali' from this greater scripture 'Satsangijivan Shastra'. This new and smaller scripture contains 1008 names of the Almighty Lord. But then Sadguru Shatanand Swami thought about a person of Kali- yug living in 21st Century, who will not have this much time to perform Path of 1008 names of Shree Hari. And therefore, Sadguru Shatanand Swami created 'Janmangal Namavali' which contains 108 names of Shree Hari. now these names can be broadly categorized into three categories. (1) Names

relating to Form of Bhagwan e.g. 'Om Shree Narnarayanay Namah:' (2) Names relating to Qualities of Bhagwan e.g. 'Om Shree Udaraya Namah:' (2) Names relating to Karm of Bhagwan e.g. 'Om Shree Pakhandochhedan Patve Namah:'.

As stated in the scriptures, those who perform 11 *Path* of this *Janmangal Namavali*, they will get the results of their desire and wish in life. The body, mind and heart also gets purified by chanting the name of Shree Hari. all other rituals prescribed by the Scriptures require a special kind of actions for purifying our body and mind. But this is the only worship which requires nothing except ardent faith and purity in heart.

While narrating the benefits of <u>Stotra</u>, Sadguru Shatanand Swmi has stated:

''एतेत्संसेवमानानां पुरुषार्थं चतुष्टये।

दुर्लभं नास्ति किमपि हरिकृष्ण प्रसादत: ॥

भूत प्रेतिपशाचानां डाकिनी ब्रह्मरक्षसाम्।

योगिनानां तथा बालगृहादिनामुपद्रवः ॥

A devotee who listens to this *Stotra* ardently and with utmost faith, all his sins are destroyed and a devotee who performs *Path* of this *Stotra*, he gets realized all the four *Purusarth – Dharma, Artham, Kama* and *Moksha*. This *Strotra* is very powerfully spiritually. 1000 Young devotees of *Shree Narnarayandev Yuvak Mandal* have taken noble vow to learn by heart this *Stotra* and to perform its Path regularly and accordingly 'Janmangal Kanthasth Abhiyan' is going to be started.

'Janmangal Katha' is also organized on every Saturday for those devotees who are specially interested in this. A Sabha will also be organized on alternate Saturdays in Ghatlodiya and Bapunagar areas. The place and timings of this Satsang Sabha would be placed in a banner in our temples at Kalupur, Naranghat, Ranip, Nava Vadaj, Bapunagar etc. All Haribhaktas and devotees are cordially invited to participate in this noble campaign.

Honour of Shree Shambhudanjithe last Acharya of Vrajbhasha Pathshala of Bhuj- by H.H. Shri Devendraprasadji Maharaj

- Prof. Suryakant Bhatt (Bhuj)

The wonderful book called 'Kachchh Darshan' of Rajkavi Shree Shambhudanji Ishwardanji Ratnu gives us glimpses about creation of the Kachchh State and its social, religious and political set up and arrangements as also the noble deeds done by the kings towards the welfare of the subject of Kachchh state. It is described in this book that, Shreeji Maharaj himself had invoked the idol images of Shree Narnarayandev in Bhujthe capital of Kachchh state. On Vaishakh Sud-5 Samvat 1879 land of the garden was offered for construction of temple and on Kartik Sud-11 Samvat 1916, the well situated therein was offered to Aadi Acharya Maharaj Shree Ayodhyaprasadji Maharaj by Maharav Shri Deshalji-II and the Queen Baijiba Vagheli. On Ashadh Sud-11 Samvat 1922 the silver doors of the inner temple were offered.

Rajkavi Shree Shambhudanji acknowledges that his first ever contact with Sampradaya as also Acharya Mahari Shree Devendraprasadji Maharaj and Acharya Maharaj Shree Tejendraprasadji Maharaj was made possible due to blessings and efforts of his Guru Sadguru Shree Balmukunddasji Swami, who hails from Guru tradition of Sadguru Brahmanand Swami and who is himself Guru of the learned and 87 years old Sadguru Dhyani Swami Shree Hariswaroopdasji.

Shree Shambhudanji writes in his book, 'Shree Balmukunddasji Swami

came to Bhuj from Muli Desh and he belonged to Lohana community. His father was Nathubhai and mother was Devkibai and his native place was village Kundal of Nal Sarovar area of Sanand Taluka. He was born on Kartak Sud-11 Samvat 1940. he obtained Saint Diksha from Acharya Maharaj 1008 Shri Vasudevprasadji Maharaj on Kartak Sud-11 Samvat 1963. He studied the scriptures from his Dharmguru Shri Sanatandasji of Muli and he came to Bhuj temple in Samvat 2001.'

Shree Shambhudanji writes in his book, 'At that time, I was working in Baug Department, and I had to take care of all gardens and parks of the State. One Haribhaktas Kanji (Dada) was given away the contract of preparing jaggery from the sugarcane crops and on that occasion the devotee had invited all the saints of Bhuj temple and Shri Balmukunddasji Swami had also come while accepting the invitation. A religious discourse took place on that occasion wherein Shri Balmukunddasji Swami sang Charni Chhandas and explained them in detail. I was surprised at this. The discourse continued for four hours. Meanwhile, I received a message from home that my young son had fallen ill and I had to rush to my home immediately. At that time Balmukund Swami told me not to worry as Bhagan Shree Swaminarayan would cure my son. He also asked me to come to Bhuj temple to perform Darshan, when my son is cured of. When I came home early in the morning, my son Puspdan was cured of the serious illness.

From that day onwards, I became the regular visitor of Bhuj temple. In Samvat 1995-1996, Sankhya Yogi Motiba of Halvad came to reside in my neighbourhood and thereby my became Satsangi devotee. One day Swamiji asked me to accept Kanthi and offered all his *Punya*, so that I can observe all Nitya-Niyam of Sampradaya prescribed in the Scriptures. Acharya Maharaj Shree Devendraprasadji Maharaj offered me Guru Mantra. I used to attend all Samaiya and would present my poems in every such occasion. Saints of Bhuj temple used to call me Satsangi Kavi. Later on I came in touch with H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj 1008 Shri Tejendraprasadji Maharaj and I received ardent love and affection from him.

FROM BLESSINGS OF H.H. SHRI GADIWALA

In 'Shrimad Bhagwat Gita' Arjuna asks Lord Shree Krishna, 'What is better? Karma or Gyan?' then Lord Shree Krishna replies, 'No one can perform Tyaga of Karma because one has to obey the qualities and characteristics received from Prakriti-Nature. And therefore, nobody can remain aloof from Karma. Moreover, the very nature of the Soul is also very active and without the presence of this soul, this human body cannot move an inch. It is because of the presence of the soul that our physical body performs all its functions naturally. There are many types of Karma. (1) Svabhavik Karma (2) Sahaj Karma (3) Niyat Karma (4) Paristhiti Prapta Karma and (5) Yagna Karma.

- (1) **Svabhavik Karma**: Our body functions of the limbs such as heart, brain, lungs are Svabhavik Karma.
- (2) **Sahaj Karma**: Functions and actions performed by a man naturally through his *Samskaras* are known as *Svabhavik Karma*.
- (3) Niyat Karma: Actions performed by human beings as per the community he belongs to such as Brahmin, Kshatriya, Vaishya and Shudra, are known as Niyat Karma.
- (4) Paristhiti Prapta Karma: Actions one has to perform under the circumstances one is placed in. there may emerge such circumstances in life which may compel him to do certain type of actions. These are known as Paristhiti Prapta Karma.
- (5) Yagna Karma: Hom Karma, Gyan Karma, Seva Yagna and such other noble deeds which one person performs are



known as Yagna Karma.

Now there are many subcategories of this *Yagna Karma*. They are as under:

- (1) **Brahma Karma**: Study of the scriptures is known as *Brahma Karma*.
- (2) **Dev Karma**: Bhakti and Upasana of the deities is known as Dev Karma.
- (3) **Pitru Karma**: Services to the Parents is recognized by the scriptures as *Pitru Karma*. One may be performing worship and *Bhakti* but if one is not rendering his services to his parents, he would not get the result of his *Bhakti*.
- (4) **Bhut Yagna**: To perform benevolent and compassionate actions towards the birds and animals is known as *Bhut Yagna*.
- (5) Manushya Karma: To have love and compassion towards other human beings is known as Manushya Karma.

Therefore, when the human beings perform all these Karmas then he is said to have rendered the best services. Therefore, it is an humble prayer to the Almighty Lord Shree Narnarayandev that all human beings perform all these *Karmas* in their life.

- Sankhya Yogi Gitaba and Anandiba (Viramgam)

On Kartak Sud-11 Prabodhini Ekadashi Samvat 1882, Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan established two Ahmedabad Desh and Vadtal Desh and established the Seat of Acharya for both

Desh. Though there were many saints who were capable of doing work of incarnation of Almighty Lord and yet they could offer only Vartamaan to the devotees. Diksha Mantra could be granted only by Acharya.

Even in *Vachanamrit*, Shreeji Maharaj has stated that, the devotees who has sought shelter of *Dharmkul*, gets a place in *Akshardham*. And thereby importance of *Dharmkul* is narrated at many places in our Scriptures.

Once our Aadi Acharya Shree Ayodhyaprasadji Maharaj graced the village Ghatila of Kachchh. Maharaj graced the house of the devotee Jetha Patel and other devotees. When Maharaj started for the journey ahead on the next day, all devotees and Jetha Patel ardently requested Maharaj to stay in their village for eleven days, as they had made all the preparations for 11 days' stay of Maharaj in their village. But the devotees accompanying Maharaj were worried about the heavy rains as it was the rainy season. Some of these devotees were also worried about the scarcity of water in the region. Most of the devotees were worried about the heavy rains.

Maharaj consoled all the devotees and Haribhaktas that, they would not be in any difficulties of nature or climate change until they all reach Ahmedabad and perform divine Darshan of the Lord Shree Narnaryandev. And all stayed for eleven days and accepted the ardent services of all the devotees and Haribhaktas of the village Ghatila.

Thereafter they all started their journey towards Ahmedabad and reached there without any obstacle and performed divine *Darshan* of the Lord Shree Narnarayandev. This reveals the ardent faith and trust, these devotees cherished in their heart towards *Dharmkul*. In the words of

Premanand Swami:

જેને જોઈએ તે આવો મોક્ષ માગવા રે લોલ આજ ધર્મવંશીને દ્વાર, નરનારી.... શીદ જાઓ છો બીજે શિર કુટવા રે લોલ યાં તો તરત થાશે, પાવન નરનારી..... ભૂંડા શીદને ભટકો છો મંત પંથમાં રે લોલ આવો સત્સંગ મેલીને મોક્ષરૂપ, નરનારી.... જુઓ આંખ ઉધાડીને વિવેકની રે લોલ, શીદ કરો ગોળ ખોળ એકપાડ, નરનારી.....

Shreeji Maharaj incarnated on this earth, performed *Leela* at different places, established *Ekantik Dharma* and after handing over the reins of *Sampradaya* to his sons both Acharya, returned to Akshardham. It was stated to Maharaj that, once *aarti* of the idol images is performed by *Acharya*, then only services of all other saints and devotees would be accepted. It is stated:

"કરશે દર્શન ને ગુણ લેશે રે, વળી પો'ચ્ય પ્રમાણે કાંઈ દેશે રે. શ્રધ્ધા સહિત સેવા કરે સોઈ રે, વળી રાજી થાશે એને જોઈ રે. એવા જન જે જે જગમાંય રે, તેની કરવી મારે સહાય રે."

In the scripture 'Purushottam Prakash' Nishkulanand Swami has talked about Vachan of Maharaj. Accordingly, all the devotees and Haribhaktas should render their services to their Guru i.e. Acharya Maharaj on the pious day of Guru Purnima.

Therefore, let us perform our ardent duties, and render our whole hearted services to our Guru by performing *poojanarchan* and obtained the blessings on the pious day of *Guru Purnima*. We should also obtained the pleasure and happiness of our Guru through our services. We should lead a righteous and religious life as per the directions of Shreeji Maharaj.
